Recommended Action: Approval of the purchase by and between the City of Joplin and Oshkosh Airport Products, LLC for the purchase of a new Class 4 ARFF Truck at the Joplin Regional Airport on an emergency basis.

**Background:** The Joplin Regional Airport submitted a *Request for Financial Support for Aircraft Rescue Firefighting (ARFF) Equipment beyond Minimum Part 139 Requirements* at the first of this year. This submission requested Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funding for Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) equipment that goes beyond the airport's current ARFF Index requirements.

Joplin Regional Airport is currently an Index A airport with less than 5 daily departures of Index B sized aircraft (E175, CRJ-700, etc.). Our current operations include two Class 3 ARFF trucks. Since February 2017 there has been an increase in the size of aircraft operating at JLN that require an Index B response. The projected commercial service growth could increase the frequency of Index B sized aircraft to more than 5 daily departures per day within the next 5 years which will require the Airport to be reclassified as an Index B facility.

**Discussion:** The FAA issued a Go Letter on April 11<sup>th</sup> for the procurement of a Class 4 ARFF Truck. Following the City of Joplin procurement policy a bid package was advertised on May 16<sup>th</sup> and we opened bids on June 14<sup>th</sup>. Oshkosh Airport Products was the low bidder and the bid was reviewed and approved by the FAA. The cost for this purchase will be paid from a future Grant based on a 95/5 Federal/Local share. The Oshkosh purchase price is a Lump Sum of \$631,374.00. The Federal share will be \$599,805.00 and the Local share will be \$31,369.00.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends approval of the Agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Oshkosh Airport Products, LLC for the purchase of a new Class 4 ARFF Truck at the Joplin Regional Airport on an emergency basis per section 2.12(4) of the Joplin Home Rule Charter.
