

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2018-129

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the acceptance of an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., for Engineering Services for the design of the Reconstruction of Taxiway D at the Joplin Regional Airport; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., for Engineering Services not to exceed the amount of three hundred twenty-seven thousand two hundred nine dollars and fifty-seven cents (\$327,209.57) for the design of the Reconstruction of Taxiway D at the Joplin Regional Airport a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his Designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That this ordinance dealing with the public improvements is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this agreement needs to be in place to meet FAA timelines.

Section 4. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance relating to public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow construction to be completed within funding time limitations.
