Recommended Action: Approval of a Construction Agreement between the City of Joplin and Dalton-Killinger Construction for Storm Project #11 – Joplin, 15th Street, Michigan Ave., and Kansas Ave. for the not to exceed amount of six hundred seventy-five thousand nine and 10/100 dollars (\$675,009.10). Funded by Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery funds.

Background: This Council Bill authorizes the City of Joplin to enter into a Construction Agreement with Dalton-Killinger Construction for Storm Project #11. City Council previously approved Storm Project #11 as a part of the Capital Plan adopted July 7, 2015 and in the Community Development Block Grant Program – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Amendment 16 of the Partial Action Plan 7 on May 16, 2016.

Storm Project #11 provides storm sewer infrastructure for the residential neighborhood between 15th & 18th Street from Wisconsin Ave to Kansas Ave. This area currently does not have an existing storm collection system. The project includes 32 new storm structures and a little over 2500 LF of concrete pipe ranging from 15”- 48” in diameter. The improvements will be located within existing street right-of-way. This project will connect to future Storm Project 12 which extends to the north of 15th Street.

Discussion: City Staff followed the City of Joplin procurement policy. The Bid Advertisement was first posted on June 3, 2018. On June 26, 2018 bids were opened and read aloud for the construction of Storm Project #11. The City of Joplin received 5 bids with Dalton-Killinger Construction being identified as the lowest, most responsive, responsible bidder. The construction firm will work closely with City staff and Olsson Associates, DBA Joplin Engineering Team (JET) in coordinating construction. The Agreement is not to exceed six hundred seventy five thousand nine and 10/100 dollars (\$675,009.10). This project is below the engineering estimate.

Recommendation: City staff recommends the approval of the Agreement in the amount of \$675,009.10 as it pertains to the CDBG-DR funded Storm Project #11 on an emergency basis. Per Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
