Recommended Action: Approval of a Construction Agreement between the City of Joplin and A-Y-1, LLC for Surface Projects 5004 and 5006 for the not to exceed amount of seven hundred twelve thousand three hundred eighty-six and 45/100 dollars (\$712,386.45). Funded by Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery funds.

Background: This Council Bill authorizes the City of Joplin to enter into a Construction Agreement with A-Y-1 for Surface Projects 5004 and 5006. City Council previously approved Surface Projects 5004 and 5006 as a part of the Capital Plan adopted July 7, 2015 and in the Community Development Block Grant Program – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Amendment 16 of the Partial Action Plan 7 on May 16, 2016.

Discussion: City Staff followed the City of Joplin procurement policy. The Bid Advertisement was first posted on May 27, 2018. On June 18, 2018 bids were opened and read aloud for the construction of Surface Projects 5004 and 5006. The City of Joplin received 4 bids with A-Y-1, LLC being identified as the lowest, most responsive, responsible bidder. Surface Project 5004 will provide curb, gutter, and surface improvements in the residential areas from 15th Street to 20th Street, between Connecticut Ave. to Range Line Rd. Surface Project 5006 includes the repair of street surfaces and alleys between 20th Street to 24th Street along Ozark Ave. and S Highview Ave. The construction firm will work closely with City staff and Anderson Engineering in coordinating construction. The Agreement is not to exceed seven hundred twelve

thousand three hundred eighty-six and 45/100 dollars (\$712,386.45).

Recommendation: City staff recommends the approval of the Agreement in the amount of \$712,386.45 as it pertains to the CDBG-DR funded Surface Projects 5004 and 5006 on an emergency basis. Per Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
