

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 2018-132**

**ORDINANCE NO**

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Joplin to enter into an agreement with A-Y-1 LLC., in the amount of Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Six and 45/100 dollars (\$712,386.45) for construction of the 5004 Surface Improvement and the 5006 Surface Improvement Projects; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the said agreement by and between the City of Joplin and A-Y-1 LLC., in the amount of Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Six and 45/100 dollars (\$712,386.45), a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto; be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. Upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid from the Community Development Block Grant Distaster Recovery Fund (CDBG-DR)

Section 4 That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
