

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 2018-140**

**ORDINANCE NO.**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City to accept a grant from the Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) for Engineering Services for the update of the Pavement Management Plan at the Joplin Regional Airport and, amending the Annual Budget of the City of Joplin for the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 as adopted by Ordinance 2017-167 on October 16, 2017; and, containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That a Grant agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) in the amount of ninety-three thousand two hundred thirteen dollars (\$93,213.00) for the update of the Pavement Management Plan at the Joplin Regional Airport, a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his Designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That fiscal year 2017-2018 budgeted appropriations as adopted by Ordinance 2017-167 be amended by increasing revenues by the total amount of Ninety-Three Thousand Two Hundred Thirteen Dollars and No cents (\$93,213.00) and by increasing appropriations by the total amount of Ninety-Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$98,120.00).

Section 4. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in revenues and appropriations.

Section 5. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance relating to public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow construction to be completed within funding time limitations and meet FAA timelines.
