SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves an amendment for the work authorization for the 44th Street Widening Project, in the not to exceed amount of Fifty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty and no/100 Dollars (\$53,860.00)

BACKGROUND

The City of Joplin has identified a number of major transportation improvement needs throughout the community. On August 5, 2014, voters approved the renewal of a 10 year, 3/8 cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax. The Capital Improvement Sales Tax program includes 14 specific projects. Two of the transportation projects included in the program are the widening of 44th Street, from Connecticut Avenue east to Range Line Road, and the widening of a part of Connecticut Avenue from 32nd Street south to 44th Street. The project scope is to widen to five lanes with bike lanes and pedestrian facilities. Additional services include retaining wall design, redesign of reinforced concrete box and storm sewer, and resubmit final plans and cost estimate for city review. This project includes the portion of Connecticut Avenue south of I-44 to 44th Street and 44th Street from Connecticut to Range Line.

FUNDING SOURCE

These payments will be made from the Capital Improvement Sales Tax Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis; being an ordinance relating to a public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Specifically, this ordinance approves construction to begin immediately in the optimal construction time during the calendar year, and appropriations for this contract have been approved in the 2018-2019 budget.
