SUMMARY

This Council Bill is an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Capital Paving & Construction, LLC., for Construction Services not to exceed the amount of seven million four hundred thirty-four thousand dollars and eighty-five cents (\$7,434,000.85) for the Reconstruction of Taxiway D at the Joplin Regional Airport.

BACKGROUND

The engineering firm of Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. amended the Pavement Management Plan to document the impact that the commercial airline equipment upgrade (heavier aircraft) is having on the existing pavement. The results of this up-gage in aircraft reflected a significant deterioration in the pavement structure for Taxiway D. Bids for this project were taken in August of 2018 and Capital Paving was certified as lowest and best bid by the FAA. The FAA issued us a Grant and it was accepted by Council on September 24, 2018 for the reconstruction project.

FUNDING SOURCE

The FAA issued a Supplemental Appropriation Funding Airport Improvement Grant (AIP No. 3-29-0037-041-2018) for the project. The Grant amount is based on the Federal share of the projected final project cost which includes the construction and inspections fees. The cost for this project will be paid from this Federal Grant based on a 95/5 Federal/Local share. The Federal Share will be \$ 7,062,300.81 and the Local Share will be \$ 371,700.04 which is included in the fiscal year 2019 budget in the Airport Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an Ordinance dealing with a general appropriation, within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
