**SUMMARY**

This Council Bill approves a transfer to Kirksville, MO certain property more particularly described as: 2015 ROUSENBAURER AIRWOLF INDEX A ARFF TRUCK VIN# 3HAWEAZR0GL735668, along with the Grant Assurance responsibilities as required by the Federal Aviation Administration for AIP Grant 3-29-0037-031-2013 issued to the Joplin Regional Airport/City of Joplin as it pertains to the above referenced equipment.

**BACKGROUND**

Due to the increased commercial service aircraft size at the Joplin Regional Airport the FAA funded a new Index B ARFF truck for our facility. The existing Index A truck is not of any use under our current operational requirements. Federal Grant Assurances for the Index A truck provide a very narrow path for the disposal of the unit. In order to release the City of Joplin of any Liability and Financial Responsibility for the Grant, an equipment transfer to a FAA eligible Airport was the best solution. The FAA identified the Kirksville Regional Airport as an eligible Airport with need in the State of Missouri.
