

AN ORDINANCE approving a Work Authorization with Allgeier Martin & Associates in the not to exceed amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$229,855.00) for 2019 Wastewater Facilities Plan funded through the Wastewater Treatment fund, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the Work Authorization with Allgeier Martin & Associates in the not to exceed amount of Two Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$229,855.00) for 2019 Wastewater Facilities Plan funded through the Wastewater Treatment fund, in the City of Joplin, Jasper County, a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the City of Joplin with Allgeier Martin & Associates.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultant’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached exhibits, in writing by the Director of Public Works, and his certification to that effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid out of the Wastewater Treatment Fund.

Section 4. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance relating to a public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow construction to be completed within funding time limitations.
