SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves a grant with MoDOT to fund Overtime and fringe benefits of officers working Hazardous Moving Violations Enforcement details. The grant also covers equipment to include reflective vests as well as professional development for two officers to attend the LETSAC Conference.

BACKGROUND

Substance-impaired drivers contributed to 25.6 percent of Missouri's traffic crash fatalities during the past five years. Alcohol remains the primary contributor to substance-impaired driving crashes; however, the number of persons under the influence of prescription medications and/or illicit drugs continues to increase. Ten percent of the children less than 15 years of age who were killed in motor vehicle crashes over the last five years, were riding with a substance-impaired driver.

FUNDING SOURCE

This grant will cover 100% of overtime and fringe benefits, reflective vests, and professional development for two officers to attend training. There is no match for this grant.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis; being an ordinance dealing generally with public peace and safety, to be an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(1) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
