SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves a Work Authorization (WA) with Allgeier, Martin & Associates, Inc. (AMA) for the 2018-2019 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Toolbox and Miscellaneous Rehab Assistance project in the not to exceed amount of Sixty-five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$65,000.00)

BACKGROUND

Since 2013, AMA has played a key part in the success of the City's annual evaluation and rehabilitation program, which has improved the reliability of the sanitary sewer collection system. On October 1, 2018, Council approved the previous WA with AMA for \$65,000 to support the planning and construction administration of Ace Pipe Cleaning's work in FY 2017-2018. Under that previous WA, AMA prepared the itemized work order for PO #2 and for PO #2019-01, which was approved by Council on May 6, 2019. They also provided construction administration services during the contractor's execution of the referenced work. Additionally, AMA, assisted city staff in developing the multi-year list of action items contained within Appendix A of the Abatement Order on Consent (AOC) between the City and the Department of Natural Resources.

AMA was selected as the on-call engineering firm most qualified to provide these professional engineering services. Their fees for this WA are within industry standards for design and construction administration. As a part of the AOC's plan to prevent bypasses, AMA will continue these same tasks for Ace's latest and future work orders, in coordination with other planned City improvements and the recommendations with the City's hydraulic model.

FUNDING SOURCE

Wastewater Treatment fund, Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of this council bill for Work Authorization with Allgeier, Martin & Associates in the amount of Sixty-five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$65,000.00) on an Emergency basis; being an ordinance relating to a public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Appropriations for this contract have been approved in the 2018-2019 budget.
