

AN ORDINANCE approving Change Order #2 for the 7th and Illinois Area Stormwater Improvements project, in the amount of One Hundred Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$105,425.00) funded through the Parks and Storm Water Sales Tax; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the change order agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Branco Enterprises Inc., in the amount of One Hundred Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$105,425.00), a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said change order agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing by the Director of Public Works, and his certification to that effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid out of the Park's and Storm Water Sales Tax Fund.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
