

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an agreement with Joplin Industrial Electric Company Inc., in the not to exceed amount of One Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Eight and 11/100 Dollars (\$172,838.11) for the LED Traffic Signal Replacement 2019-2020 Project; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That an agreement be accepted with Joplin Industrial Electric Company Inc., in the not to exceed amount of One Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Eight and 11/100 Dollars (\$172,838.11) for the LED Traffic Signal Replacement 2019-2020 Project. A true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached exhibits, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid from the Transportation Sales Tax Fund.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
