SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves a Purchase Order to Ace Pipe Cleaning, Inc., for the 2018 & 2019 Evaluation and Rehabilitation of Wastewater Collection System Project in the amount of Six Hundred Fifty-one Thousand Forty-Six and No/100 Dollars (\$651,046.00).

BACKGROUND

On May 20, 2019, Council authorized the City of Joplin to enter an Abatement Order on Consent (AOC) with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) and Wastewater Treatment Plant Bypasses. Appendix A of that agreement contained the City's 2026 Activities Plan of Its System Renewal & Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Prevention Program, which outlines the strategic approach to reducing inflow and infiltration (I&I) within any given sanitary sewer basin. The AOC contains specific 3-year milestone quantities of work to which the City will be held accountable: lineal feet of cured-in-place or new PVC pipe; lineal feet of smoke testing of sewer mains; number of lateral connection repairs, lateral launches, and rehabbed manholes. The primary mechanism for the City to meet its AOC goals is by utilizing the Evaluation and Rehabilitation of Wastewater Collection System contracts with Ace Pipe Cleaning, Inc. (Ace).

The current contract with Ace, approved by Council on Nov. 6, 2017, has allowed City staff to issue two purchase orders in FY 2017-2018 totaling \$1.15 million, along with a \$350,000 purchase order earlier this FY. The proposed purchase order builds on the work done earlier this year, namely, repairing public-side defects discovered during recent smoke testing work and CCTV evaluations. The Exhibit map shows the basins in which reconstruction work will be done.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Wastewater Maintenance fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis; being an ordinance relating to a public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME

RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
