ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving a Work Authorization with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Co., Inc. in the not to exceed amount of Five Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Five and no/100 Dollars (\$538,945.00) for the Tin Cup Parallel Force Main project; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the Work Authorization with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Co., Inc. in the not to exceed amount of Five Hundred Thirt- Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Five and no/100 Dollars (\$538,945.00) for the Tin Cup Parallel Force Main project in the City of Joplin and Newton County a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, be the same and is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultant’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Fund

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance dealing with a public improvement, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
