SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves agreement for professional services between the City of Joplin and Keenoy Preservation. Scope of work includes an intensive historic survey of the neighborhood.

BACKGROUND

The Joplin Historic Preservation Commission, in continuation of the responsibility of the Commission to identify and protect the historic assets of the City, is completing the East Town survey through this second phase. Once completed The Historic Preservation Commission will continue with the next steps of the recommendation and nomination of Local and National Historic Districts. These districts are an important part of the City Preservation Plan and the long-range neighborhood plans of the Community Development Office.

FUNDING SOURCE

These payments are included in the FY 2019-20 budget of the Historic Preservation Commission budget for consultants and will be reimbursed 60% by the Department of Natural Resources Historic Preservation Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

The Historic Preservation Commission and staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on a non-emergency basis.
