SUMMARY

This Council Bill changes certain existing health department fees related to business licenses.

BACKGROUND

The City recently completed the biennial user fee review, which was discussed with City Council at the budget work session on September 24, 2019. User fees are fees for services for specific users. User fees should recover most of the related cost of providing the service, so general taxes are not supporting services for specific users. Under Hancock provisions, the City is only allowed to recover the cost of providing the service. As detailed in the biennial user fee review, certain user fees need to be increased to recover more of the costs associated with providing these services.

In the fee review, staff proposed various changes related to business license fees.

The proposed changes are as follows:

- Change the Health Permit-Low Risk fee from \$110.00 to \$115.00
- Change the Health Permit-Medium Risk fee from \$220.00 to \$230.00
- Change the Health Permit-High Risk fee from \$330.00 to \$345.00
- Change the Health Permit-Swimming Pool-Seasonal Facility fee from \$125.00 to \$131.00
- Change the Health Permit-Swimming Pool-Yearly Facility fee from \$300.00 to \$315.00
- Change the Health Permit-Change of ownership inspection fee from \$40.00 to \$42.00
- Change the Health Permit-New construction/remodel inspection fee from \$125.00 to \$131.00

The fee changes will be effective on April 1, 2020.

FUNDING SOURCE

This revenue is included in the fiscal year 2020 general fund budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends this council bill be approved on first reading.
