SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves an Airport Agreement for the operation of commercial Airline service by and between the City of Joplin and American Airlines, Inc.

BACKGROUND

American Airlines is to occupy space and operate commercial air service in the Commercial Terminal Building at the Joplin Regional Airport. This agreement outlines the certain premises and facilities, rights, licenses, services and privileges in connection with and on the Airport, subject to the terms and conditions set forth within the agreement for ticket counter area, office area, and baggage handling area along with the compensation for the ARFF/Security and landing fees.

The lease term is retroactive to begin July 1, 2019 for a term of 5 years.
