SUMMARY

The Health Department requests consideration of Council Bill No. 2019-620 that repeals Chapter 30, Businesses, Article III, Licenses, Section 30-179, Sale of tobacco products or rolling papers to minors.

BACKGROUND

Council Bill 2019-619 amends Chapter 62, Health and Sanitation, by enacting a new Article X, Tobacco 21 Act. Section 30-179 is inconsistent with the Tobacco 21 Act because Section 30-179 prohibits tobaccos sales to persons less than 18 years of age. Section 30-179 should be repealed in order to eliminate this inconsistently with the Tobacco 21 Act.

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2019-620

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE repealing Chapter 30, Businesses, Article III, Licenses, Section 30-179, Sale of tobacco products or rolling papers to minors.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

WHEREAS, Council Bill 2019-619 amends Chapter 62, Health and Sanitation, by enacting a new Article X, Tobacco 21 Act;

WHEREAS, Section 30-179 is inconsistent with the Tobacco 21 Act because the former prohibits tobacco sales to persons less than 18 years of age;

WHEREAS, Section 30-179 should be repealed in order to eliminate this inconsistency with the Tobacco 21 Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 30, Businesses, Article III, Licenses, Section 30-179, Sale of tobacco products or rolling papers to minors, is hereby repealed.
