**SUMMARY**

This Council Bill authorizes the City to enter into a purchase order with Jon's Mid America Fire Apparatus Inc. for the purpose of purchasing TNT Extrication Equipment.

**BACKGROUND**

This Council bill proposes the purchase of TNT Extrication Equipment. The Fire Department put out bids on February 16, 2020 and on March 16, 2020 we held a bid opening and received four bids. The lowest bid was received by Jon's Mid America Fire Apparatus Inc. In the amount of \$113,999.40, however there were a few options that we did not accept and that brought the cost down to \$112,554.60

This extrication equipment is being funded by an AFG (Assistance to Firefighters Grant) that the Fire Department was awarded in August 2019 and it is a matching grant that the city is required to pay only 10% of the cost or \$11,255.46.

The technical specifications of the extrication equipment meet all the needs of the Fire Department.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The Fiscal Year 2020 budget included replacing extrication equipment for the amount of \$169,400.00 this includes grant money and money from the General Fund.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an emergency basis.
