

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2020-136

ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Joplin to enter into a construction agreement with JKS Concrete Inc., in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Three and 00/100 Dollars (\$478,623.00) for construction of the 4th and Porter Culvert Replacement project; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the said construction agreement by and between the City of Joplin and JKS Concrete Inc., in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Three and 00/100 Dollars (\$478,623.00) for construction of the 4th and Porter Culvert Replacement project funded through the Parks and Stormwater Sales Tax, in the City of Joplin, Jasper County, a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid from the Parks and Stormwater Sales Tax fund.

Section 4. That the City of Joplin hereby declares that this Ordinance relating to a public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Specifically, this ordinance approves construction to begin immediately in order to address the public safety issue arising from the collapse of the CMP pipe, which include the presence of sinkholes and the risk of the undermining of the sidewalk and road on 4th street, and appropriations for this contract have been approved in the 2019-2020 budget.
