SUMMARY

This is a 90/10 reimbursable agreement. The total amount of the proposed marketing program is Sixty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and No Cents (\$66,667.00). The amount of the grant award to be reimbursed to the City is Sixty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$60,000.00). The amount of local matching funds, and/or other resources, to be furnished by the City of Joplin is Six Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Seven and no/100 Dollars (\$6,667.00). This Airport Aid Agreement will be used to promote Commercial Airline service at the Joplin Regional Airport.

BACKGROUND

This Grant Agreement is entered into by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission and the City of Joplin for a grant of funds under State Air Service Program. The Commission has agreed to award funds with the understanding that such funds will be used for a program pursuant to this Agreement for the purposes generally described in the Joplin Regional Airports grant application/request for promotion of Commercial Air Service. This grant will provide advertising funds for existing/new service. The funds will be used to promote the service within the JLN Market area which includes portions of Kansas, Oklahoma, and Arkansas

FUNDING SOURCE

The Local Match Share will come from the Airport Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an ordinance dealing with general appropriation, within the meaning of Section 2.12(4) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to meet MoDot Guidelines for grant acceptance.
