SUMMARY:

The following agreement is between the City of Joplin and Economic Security Corporation of Southwest Area to manage the 2019 Homeowner Rehabilitation Program for income eligible homeowners.

BACKGROUND:

Economic Security Corporation has operated a successful homeowner rehabilitation program for numerous years. Currently projects that were funded under 2018 program year funds are being completed, and the Community Development office desires to make available 2019 program year funds to allow activities to remain uninterrupted. The attached agreement is a renewal of funding for Economic Security Corporation to continue the Homeowner Rehabilitation Program on the behalf of the Joplin HOME Consortium.

FUNDING SOURCE

This Council Bill provides One Hundred Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and Seventy Five Cents (\$109,784.75) from HOME Investment Partnership Grant M19DC290209.

RECOMMENDATION

These activities have received prior approval from the Council as part of the 2019 Action Plan.
