

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2021-110

ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving an agreement with Allied Services, LLC hereinafter referred to as “Republic Services” to provide curbside trash and recycling pick-up for single-family and duplex residential living units and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin with an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Whereas, since April 1, 2016 the City of Joplin has managed residential trash service through an exclusive franchise agreement with Republic Services and said agreement expired on March 31, 2021 with the option of two additional one-year extensions.

Whereas, the City of Joplin accepted three competitive, sealed Proposals (RFP-101-2020) on October 9, 2020 for residential trash and recycling services. All bids were rejected upon Republic Services offer to extend their contract by one year.

Whereas, on February 1, 2021 the City of Joplin accepted Republic Services one-year offer of extension to the current contract which includes a 2% price increase between April 1, 2021 through the expiration of the extension on March 31, 2022.

Whereas, acceptance of this five-year contract with Republic Services will nullify the recently accepted agreement extension and will begin service on July 1, 2021 and expire on June 30, 2026.

Whereas, the City’s FY 2020-2021 budget provides for “sanitation charges” and “residential trash administration” and the FY 2021-2022 budget will provide for the same.

Section 1. That the said five-year agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Republic Services a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto; be and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance provides for the protection and preservation of the public health of the community by ensuring the uninterrupted collection and disposal of solid waste thereby minimizing the proliferation of vermin and unsanitary conditions within the community in accordance with Section 2.12 (1) of the Joplin City Charter with an emergency clause.
