

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 2021-132**

**ORDINANCE NO**

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Joplin to enter into a construction agreement with Goins Enterprise for the On Call Infrastructure and Utility Cuts 2021 project; and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Goins Enterprises, for the On Call Infrastructure and Utility Cuts 2021 project, a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid from the Transportation Sales Tax fund for items pertaining to utility cuts restoration and the Parks and Stormwater Sales Tax fund for items pertaining to minor system improvements. .

Section 4. That the City of Joplin hereby declares that this ordinance relating to a public involvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and the council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Specifically, approval of this council bill on an emergency basis will allow for the continued and uninterrupted service in repair of City infrastructure needed after utility cuts by utility companies during the course of their work within the public right-of-way.
