SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves an agreement with G&G Construction Company, Inc., for the expansion of the Turkey Creek WWTF Ultraviolet (UV) Disinfection in the amount of Three Hundred Four Thousand Eight Hundred Forty and No/100 Dollars (\$304,840.00)

BACKGROUND

The Ultraviolet (UV) Disinfection building was placed in service in 2011 at the Turkey Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility. The UV system provides for disinfection of the plant effluent prior to discharge to Turkey Creek. The maximum allowable flow through the UV disinfection system is currently 24 million gallons per day (MGD). Additional hydraulic capacity is needed to reduce the frequency of sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) and plant bypasses. Planned improvements to the UV disinfection facilities will increase the treatment capacity of the UV system by nearly fifty percent, to 35-MGD. The project will include the design of additional channels and piping and associated UV disinfection equipment.

Staff followed the procurement policy by bidding this item out and G&G Construction, Inc., was the low bidder. G&G Construction has done other construction projects at the Turkey Creek WWTF. CB 2020-135 was a Work Authorization with Allgeier Martin to do the Design for this project.

FUNDING SOURCE

FY2020- 2021 budget of the Wastewater fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill, approving a work authorization on an Emergency basis due to public health concerns associated with sanitary sewer overflows, and equipment replacement, being an ordinance relating to a public improvement, it is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
