

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2021-133

ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANC authorizing the City of Joplin to enter into an agreement with G&G Construction Inc., in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$239,000.00) for construction services associated with the Turkey Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility North Digester Thickener on behalf of the City of Joplin and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; amending the Annual Budget of the City of Joplin for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 as adopted by Ordinance 2020-156 on October 19, 2020; and, containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the agreement by and between the City of Joplin and G&G Construction, Inc., in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$239,000.00) for construction services associated with the rehabilitation of the Turkey Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility North Digester Thickener on behalf of the City of Joplin; true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That fiscal year 2020-2021 budgeted appropriations as adopted by Ordinance 2020-156 be amended by increasing appropriations by the total amount of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand and No Cents (\$239,000.00).

Section 4. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in appropriations.

Section 5. That upon final approval and acceptance of G&G Construction's work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached work authorization, in writing to the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, G&G Construction Inc., shall be paid from the Sanitary Sewer Fund.

Section 6. That the City of Joplin hereby declares that this Ordinance, approving a construction agreement on an Emergency basis due to public health concerns associated with sanitary sewer, and equipment replacement, being an ordinance relating to a public improvement, it is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
