SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves an agreement with PB Hoidale Company, Inc., for the installation of an Automated Fuel System with DEF dispenser in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Eight and 71/100 Dollars (\$197,488.71).

BACKGROUND

Staff has been discussing the replacement of the Diesel pumps at the Public Works Center (PWC) for the past several years as the dispensers are antiquated and the current Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF) procedure is inconvenient. Currently, staff must fill up with Diesel and then drive to the rear of the garage to add DEF to the equipment. This contract will allow City staff the ability to pump equipment with diesel and DEF at the Fuel Island. Staff has also looked at replacing the current key process with a pin pad entry because of the many difficulties and maintenance issues experienced. Neither of the two bids received, allowed for the decommissioning of the two Underground Storage tanks. Bidders were offered three options for their RFP reply, one of which was installation without decommissioning Underground Storage Tanks (UST).

Staff followed the procurement policy by bidding this item out and PB Hoidale Company, Inc., was the low bidder. PB Hoidale Company, Inc., has worked satisfactorily with the city on other fuel issues at the Public Works Center.
