SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves an agreement with All-American Pride LLC., for the installation of an Automated Fuel System with DEF dispenser in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$220,000.00).

BACKGROUND

Staff has been discussing the replacement of the Diesel pumps at the Public Works Center (PWC) for the past several years as the dispensers are antiquated and the current Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF) procedure is inconvenient. Currently, staff must fill up with Diesel and then drive to the rear of the garage to add DEF to the equipment. This contract will allow City staff the ability to pump equipment with diesel and DEF at the Fuel Island. Staff has also looked at replacing the current key process with a pin pad entry because of the many difficulties and maintenance issues experienced. Neither of the two bids received, allowed for the decommissioning of the two Underground Storage tanks. Bidders were offered three options for their RFP reply, one of which was installation without decommissioning Underground Storage Tanks (UST).

Staff followed the procurement policy by bidding this item out and PB Hoidale Company, Inc., was the apparent low bidder. Staff proceeded with presenting this to Council in CB 2021-604. PB Hoidale then informed staff that they made an error on the bid documents, the price didn't include the dispensers and key control units. With the error corrected All-American Pride is the low bidder. Staff has consulted the City Attorney's office for guidance, and they recommended using the next bidder.
