SUMMARY REQUEST:

This council bill approves the contract by and between the City of Joplin and with Nelson’s Enterprises.to remove the structures, and any remaining debris including foundation and footings at 223 Galena Ave.

BACKGROUND:

The above listed address was “tagged” as a dangerous building on March 1, 2021. The structures were determined to be dangerous under sub sections of the Dangerous Building Code (Section 26-612, Joplin City Code). On July 2, 2021, an advertisement for bids was published in the Joplin Globe with bids being received on July 16, 2021, for the removal of structures and any remaining debris including footings and foundations. At that time bids were received as follows:

Gator Demolition	\$5,499.00
B&D Yardbuilders	\$5,586.00
Big Johns	\$6,900.00
Clay Cole Tricking	\$7,000.00
Nelson’s Enterprises	\$4,850.00

A Special Tax Bill will be issued after the demotion is completed. The Special Tax Bill acts as a lien against the property until is paid, with the owner having five years to pay off the assessment. The bill also is a personal debt of the owner.

FUNDING SOURCE:

These payments are included in the FY 2020-21 budget of the Revolving Fund.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

City Staff recommends that the demolition removal contract be awarded to Nelson’s Enterprises for \$4,850.00 and that it be approved on an emergency basis within the meaning of Section 2.12(1) for the immediate preservation of public health and welfare.
