SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves agreement for professional services between the City of Joplin and Owen & Eastlake Ltd. Scope of work includes a district nomination to the National Register of Historic Places.

BACKGROUND

The Joplin Historic Preservation Commission, in continuation of the responsibility of the Commission to identify and protect the historic and cultural resources of the City, is nominating the Broadway District to the National Register. This district is an important part of the City Preservation Plan and the long-range neighborhood plans of the Community Development Office.

FUNDING SOURCE

These payments are included in the FY 2021 budget of the Historic Preservation Commission budget for consultants and will be reimbursed 60% by the Department of Natural Resources Historic Preservation Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

The Historic Preservation Commission and staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on a non-emergency basis.
