ORDINANCE NO

AN ORDINANCE approving a Contract by and between the City of Joplin and Matrix Consulting Group, Ltd. to perform a Benchmark Study in the amount not to exceed amount Ninety-Nine Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$99,000.00) for consulting services; authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the Contract with Matrix Consulting Group, Ltd. in the not to exceed amount of Ninety-Nine Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$99,000.00) for professional consulting services for preparing the City of Joplin’s Benchmark Study, a true and accurate copy of said contract being attached hereto and incorporated herein, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract, in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in appropriations.

Section 4. That upon the final approval and acceptance of the consultant’s work under said contract, in substantial conformance with the attached work authorization, in writing by the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the consultant shall be paid from the General Fund.

Section 5: That the ordinance is adopted on First Reading and will be moved to Second and Third Reading.
