SUMMARY

This Resolution grants approval for the support of the City's intent to apply for the Federal Community Project Funding Request for various qualifying capital projects.

BACKGROUND

The Federal Government is accepting Community Project Funding Requests that fit within four accounts within the Transportation, Housing and Urban Development and Related Agencies appropriations. The projects that are being submitted for consideration are as follows:

- Zora Street Widening/Improvements from Range Line to MO249 (\$6 million)
- Tin Cup Trail with Underpass at 32nd Street (\$6 million)
- East Town Infrastructure and Revitalization (\$5.4 million)
- Joplin East Industrial Park Culvert Replacements (\$2.8 million)
- Replacement and Relocation of Fire Station #3 (\$6.5 million)

All of these projects will have a significant impact for the Community in terms of economic development and public service. One component of the Request is community engagement and support for the projects. With this resolution, Council is adopting support for the need of these projects and committing to the completion of the projects as set forth in the Community Project Funding Request.
