

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2022-513

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE amending the Annual Budget of the City of Joplin for the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 as adopted by Ordinance 2021-149 on October 18, 2021, to adjust appropriations and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the City of Joplin, Missouri passed Ordinance 2021-149 on October 18, 2021, which estimated revenues and appropriated funds for the fiscal year 2021-2022; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Joplin has previously approved the programs and projects which require additional appropriations for completion.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That fiscal year 2021-2022 budgeted appropriations as adopted by Ordinance 2021-149 be amended by increasing revenue by the total amount of Four Hundred Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$405,250.00) and by increasing appropriations by the total amount of Six Hundred Six Thousand Three Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$606,300.00) for the purposes and amounts as shown in Schedule “A” attached hereto.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in appropriations.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared by the City Council to be an emergency within this meaning of Section 2.12 (4), of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, in order to continue the day-to-day operations of the City and as such shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
