SUMMARY

This grant offer is to update the Pavement Management Plan Project No. 3-29-0037-049-2022 at Joplin Regional Airport not to exceed the amount of One Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Four Hundred Five and no/00 Dollars (\$171,405.00) it is provided in accordance with FAA-AIP funding.

BACKGROUND

This project funds the Pavement Management Plan and Pavement Condition Index Update, which is required every three years as an AIP grant condition for accepting funds to improve airfield pavements. This is needed to revise records of pavement sections that need maintenance, rehabilitation, and reconstruction. The grant is based on a 95/5 Federal / Local share. The Federal share will be \$171,405 and the local share will be \$9021.30 for a total project cost of \$180,426.00

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an ordinance dealing with a general appropriation, within the meaning of Section 2.12(4) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to accept grant funding within time limitations and meet FAA-AIP grant timelines.
