

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2022-132

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the acceptance of a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration Airport Improvement Program (FAA-AIP) for the Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Building Design Services at the Joplin Regional Airport and authorizing the City Manager or his Designee to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That a Grant agreement by and between the City of Joplin and the Federal Aviation Administration Airport Improvement Program (FAA-AIP) not to exceed the amount of Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$332,574.00) for the Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Building Design Services at the Joplin Regional Airport; a true and accurate copy of said agreement being attached here to and incorporated herein, Exhibit A; is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his Designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 3. That the City of Joplin declares that this ordinance dealing with a general appropriation is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(4) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow grant acceptance to be completed and meet FAA-AIP timelines.
