**SUMMARY**

This grant agreement is for Design Services to relocate the Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Building with Grant No. 3-29-0037-048-2022 at the Joplin Regional Airport not to exceed the amount of Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy-Four and 00/00 Dollars (\$332,574.00).

**BACKGROUND**

This project funds the Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Facility Design which will plan to replace the current ARFF Facility built in 1976 which is located on the General Aviation Ramp. The new facility will be in a more centralized location near the Commercial Terminal Building which will increase safety for the airport. This grant is based on a 95/5 Federal /Local share. The Federal share will be \$332,574 and the local share will be \$17,504.00 for a total project cost of \$350,077.00.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an ordinance relating to public improvement, within the meaning of Section 2.12(4) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow grant acceptance to be completed and meet FAA-AIP timelines.
