SUMMARY

This Council Bill is an agreement by and between the City of Joplin and Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., for Engineering Design Services not to exceed the amount of three hundred fifty thousand, seventy-eight and 00/100 dollars (\$350,078.00) for the ARFF Building at the Joplin Regional Airport.

BACKGROUND

In 2021 Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. was the chosen firm of record for engineering services at the Joplin Regional Airport for the current five year period. An Independent Fee Estimate (IFE) was conducted, and the contract amount approved by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). On council bill no. 2022-132 the City of Joplin accepted FAA grant no. 3-29-0037-48-2022 for ARFF Building Engineering Design Services in the amount of \$332,574.00.00 with a local share of \$17,504.00.00 for a total project cost of \$350,078.00. This project will be based on 95/5 federal local share.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis, being an ordinance related to public improvement, within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this council bill needs to be approved in order to allow construction to be completed within funding time limitations.
