### **SUMMARY**

This Council Bill authorizes the City Manager or his designee to approve a work authorization with Allgeier, Martin and Associates in the not to exceed amount of Ninety-Six Thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$96,000.00) for professional engineering consulting services for design services associated with the Tin Cup Trail Phase II design.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Parks and Stormwater Sales Tax was approved by voters in 2021. One of the items listed on the projects to be funded by the tax was the Tin Cup Trail Phase II. The Tin Cup Trail will provide over a mile of new trail along Tin Cup Creek, connecting the St. Johns Trail and the trails in McIndoe Park together. Phase II of the trail is the southern portion of the trail and will be the final phase. Phase I is being designed by City staff, however Phase II potentially contains multiple creek crossings and other associated challenges. Due to this, a consultant was selected to assist with designing Phase II.

City staff selected Allgeier, Martin and Associates from the City's list of on call consultants, for professional engineering consulting services for the design services associated with the Tin Cup Trail Phase II design. Allgeier, Martin and Associates will develop and design preliminary and final construction plans for the improvement as well as assist with any environmental permitting, such as a Floodplain Development Permit, that will be needed. City staff reviewed the fees submitted by Allgeier, Martin and Associates for the engineering consulting services and found them to be within industry standards.

### **FUNDING SOURCE**

These payments are included in the FY 2021-22 budget of the Parks and Stormwater Sales Tax.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends approval of this bill on first reading.
