

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-010

A RESOLUTION of the City of Joplin, Missouri, approving the final prioritized Community Project List in order to pursue various Federal, State and County grants and committing to the completion of the projects as set forth in the grant requirements, if awarded.

WHEREAS, the City developed a list of partially-funded or unfunded Community Projects based on community input through various master plans and action plans; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council and the city staff of Joplin prioritized the Community Projects based on various categories, which has resulted in a ranking of high, medium and low priorities; and,

WHEREAS, the ranked Community Projects will have a significant long-term economic and public service impact for the Community if additional grant revenues become available; and,

WHEREAS, various grant applications require evidence of community support through a Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of Joplin, Missouri, desires to approve the final prioritized Community Project List in order to pursue various Federal, State and County grants for long-term improvement and job enhancement or job creation for our community.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Joplin, Missouri hereby approves the final prioritized Community Project List in order to pursue various Federal, State and County grants as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 2. The City of Joplin, Missouri is committed to completing the prioritized projects as set forth in the grant requirements, if the grant is awarded to the City.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, hereby is authorized to prepare and submit documents which are necessary in applying for these grants.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
