

AN ORDINANCE approving a purchase agreement between the City of Joplin and Midwest Transit Equipment Inc.in the amount of Three Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand, Fourteen and 00/100 Dollars (\$378,014.00) for the purchase of three light duty cut-a-way vehicles with Americans with Disabilities (ADA) compliant lifts, on behalf of the City of Joplin and authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Joplin; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Joplin, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. That a purchase agreement be awarded to Midwest Transit Equipment Inc. in the amount of Three Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Fourteen and 00/100 Dollars (\$378,014.00) for the purchase of three light duty cut-a-way vehicles with ADA lifts is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin, Missouri, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement, or agreement in substantially similar form, by and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budgeted appropriations as adopted by Ordinance 2021-523 be amended by increasing revenue in the Transportation Sales Tax account by One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand, Fourteen and 00/100 Dollars (\$137,014.00).

Section 4. That upon final approval and acceptance of the purchase agreement, in substantial conformance with the attached agreement, in writing to the Director of Public Works and his certification to the effect to the Director of Finance, the agreement shall be paid from the Transportation Sales Tax fund.

Section 5. That the City of Joplin declares that this Ordinance dealing with public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage. Specifically, this Council Bill needs to be approved as an emergency ordinance in order to complete the purchase within funding limitations.
