#### CALL TO ORDER

President Roger Doman called the meeting to order at 2:04 p.m.

#### **Agenda Items**

#### Review of previous meeting minutes

Melissa Rodgers made a motion to approve the December 9, 2020 board minutes as presented, seconded by James Weber motion carried on an 7-0 vote.

#### **Treasurers Report for December (Presented by Steve Taylor)**

A motion was made by James Weber to accept the December 2020 Treasurers Report, seconded by Forrest Reed, motion carried on a 7-0 vote.

#### **Event Discussion**

#### National

- I. NCCAA Men's and Women's Division I and II National Cross-Country Championships, November 14, 2020 Mr. Hull said the final total is 191 room nights generated from this event. JSA will also be putting in another bid to not only host this event again for 2021 and perhaps beyond.
- II. ACCA Men's and Women's National Basketball Championships, March 2-5, 2021 Mr. Hull said this event will be held again at Ozark Christian College. The tournament is still on as of right now. There will be 8-10 men's and unknown number of women's teams.
- III. NCCAA Men's and Women's Division II National Basketball Championships March 10-13, 2021 Mr. Hull said a Zoom meeting scheduled for next Wednesday at 9:30 a.m. This event is still on. There will be eight men's teams and eight women's teams. There will be no banquet on Tuesday night this year.

  State
- **I. MCSAA Winter Championships, February 18-20, 2021** Mr. Hull said at this time 28 boys' teams and 24 girls' teams scheduled for this year. There was a total of 57 teams last year. There will be no cheerleading event with no venue to host it as Memorial Hall is not available. As of right now we are using Carthage YMCA and Joplin North. We are still looking for another location at this time for Thursday.

#### Local

- **I. Kaminsky Classic, January 6-9, 2021** Mr. Hull said the event had six teams this year with four local teams in Joplin, Webb City, Carl Junction and Nevada, one regional team added at last minute in Clever and one team from Kansas City in William Chrisman. Mr. Hull said the plan is to return the tournament back to eight teams next year with four local and four out of the area teams. A total of 12 room nights were generated this year.
- II. Club MVP Volleyball Tournaments, Multiple Events Mr. Hull said Sarah Wall and Austin Gripka with Club MVP Volleyball host a series of travel volleyball tournaments. The first tournament was January 2-3

with 67 teams generating 60 room nights. The second tournament, the Big Kahuna, will have 96 teams held this weekend and the Battle in the Junction the last weekend of February will have over 100 teams.

III. MCDA Jam for the Jackets, February 8-9, 2021 — Mr. Hull said the event was scheduled to return to Galena High School, however Kansas has placed attendance restrictions on sports events allowing only two spectators per athlete. MCDA could not limit its attendance and JSA actively pursued other venues in the Joplin metro and failed to secure an alternative venue. MCDA decided to move the event to Springfield for 2021 and hopes to return to Joplin in 2022.

IV. NAIA Early Season College Baseball, February — Mr. Hull said 16 teams are scheduled to be in Joplin here the third week of February at Joe Becker, Wendell Redden, Joplin High School and Carl Junction, 12 teams the fourth weekend of February at Joe Becker, Wendell Redden and Joplin High School.

#### **Old Business**

A) FY2020 Audit, Approval of Audit and Form 990 — Ben Miller, CPA, presented the final report on the FY2020 Audit. Mr. Miller said it was a clean audit. A motion was made by Melissa Rodgers to accept the Fiscal Year 2020 Audit, seconded by Dan McCreary, motion carried on a 7-0 vote. A motion was made by Jhan Hurn to approve Form 990, seconded by Melissa Rodgers, motion carried on a 7-0 vote.

#### **New Business**

A) Approval of event agreements — A motion was made by James Weber to approve the NCCAA Basketball agreement with Ozark Christian College, seconded by Christopher Beyer motion carried a 7-0 vote. A motion was made by Dan McCreary to approve the Premier Baseball 17-under, 16-under and 15-under agreement, seconded by Christopher Beyer motion carried on a 7-0 vote. Mike Greninger said the board could review agreements for MidAmerica Baseball, Five Tool Baseball and AABC Baseball next month.

#### **Any Other Business**

A motion was made by Christopher Beyer to go into closed session with adjourn following the end of the closed session, seconded by James Weber motion carried a 7-0 vote.
