Parks and Recreation Department Annual Report


Parks and Recreation Director Paul Bloomberg presented the 2018 annual report for his department.

Director Bloomberg stated the Joplin Parks and Recreation Department is responsible for the City's recreational programs and maintains 24 City-owned parks and greenspaces. Other facilities include Memorial Hall, 3 aquatic centers, 4 cemeteries, Joe Becker Stadium, the Joplin Athletic Complex, and Schifferdecker Golf Course. The Department is responsible for over 1,000 acres of park land, including walking, hiking and biking trails. Participation in most of the recreation programs continues to increase. 2019 numbers are expected to surpass 2018.

Director Bloomberg stated he has a great staff and he believes the Joplin Parks and Recreation Department provides quality parks, services, and programs to enhance the quality of life for the citizens of Joplin and surrounding communities.

The city council thanked Director Bloomberg for his report and commented on the beautiful design of the report. Paul credited Carla Bond, Business Development Director for Parks & Rec, for producing the report, in-house.
