RE: Weekly Report

Good afternoon, everyone. You are receiving this memo a day earlier than usual because I will be out of the office tomorrow, but I'll be available by phone, text or email if you need to reach me. Otherwise, Dan Pekarek will be in charge.

Meetings

- On Tuesday I met with the neighborhood improvement staff to discuss our code enforcement process and procedures, in light of recent testimony at a council meeting when a neighbor complained of someone's trash in their yard. That issue is being investigated, but we have identified some other issues that I need to discuss with our courts staff before we present some options to the council regarding recommendations for changes to any of our processes/ordinances, if they are required.
- On Wednesday I met with public works, parks, fire and fleet maintenance staff to discuss the consolidation of fire and fleet maintenance under the same building at the Public Works Center. You may recall as part of the reorganization of the public works department last fall, that fleet operations was moved under the city manager's office and at that time we identified a potential for financial savings and process improvement by consolidating the fire and fleet operations. We are moving forward with that plan, and have set a target date of August 1st for completion. Staff is identifying any building modifications that may need to be made, which could result in a budget adjustment, but most of the work can be accomplished in-house to keep expenses down. I will keep you posted.
- Also on Wednesday, I met with the CALEA assessors who are in town this week as part of the police department re-certification process. This is their second recertification. No major issues have been identified at this point that require immediate action, but the chief and I will sit down together if any concerns are raised.
- Finally on Wednesday, I met with Director Allgood to discuss the filling of the city attorney position. We will handle the position search in-house through our HR department, and I have asked Director Allgood to meet with City Attorney Head to move that process forward.

- This morning Director Cotten and I sat in on a conference call with representatives of the baseball team, who will be in attendance for our work session on Monday night to discuss the minor league baseball project. The owners are planning to announce the team name Monday afternoon prior to meeting with the council for the work session. At the team's and staff's request, representatives from Morelock-Ross will also be in attendance Monday night. They built the stadium in Springfield for the Cardinals minor-league affiliate and can offer some insight from a developer's perspective as it pertains to our minor league baseball project.
- This afternoon we are scheduled to meet with our newest city council members for their orientation.

Miscellaneous

- Future meeting dates we have discussed at one time or another, but that you should be aware of:
 - April 28th will be the TIF Commission meeting/public hearing to hear details about the Hope Valley TIF project at I-44 and Range Line.
 - April 29th we will have a special meeting to discuss two topics – the project recommendations of the CIST committee, and to proceed on selecting a search firm for the city manager position. City Attorney Head has already provided you with the responses from the firms for your review.
 - May 12th we will have a work session to get an update from our Wallace-Bajjali partners, and to discuss the proposed Community Improvement District at the mall.
- I mentioned last week that the parks department will be putting out a comprehensive survey asking residents for their opinions on a number of parks and recreation topics. Attached is a draft of that survey. We will release it in late May to the public and have hard copies available for residents.
- The farmer's market will officially kick off on May 15th, 4:30 p.m. at Ewert Park. Due to a favorable response from vendors and the public, we will also host a Saturday market at the same location, tentatively set for 9 a.m. to Noon. I am optimistic about the potential for growth of our market, and I would like to recognize Paul Bloomberg and Matt Wright, from our parks and planning departments, respectively, for their efforts.

If you have any questions about these or any other items, please don't hesitate to contact me. Otherwise, I hope you enjoy your weekend, and I look forward to seeing everyone Monday night.
