

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Joplin Area Transportation Study Organization (JATSO) is seeking a 45 day public comment period for the proposed revisions to the Public Involvement Plan (PIP). The revisions are regarding the posting of project information to the JATSO webpage for amendments to the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and the Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP). However, comments for any portion of the PIP may be submitted for consideration. Legal notices will no longer be required for minor modifications or amendments to the TIP and UPWP under the new revisions. JATSO is the transportation planning agency for the Joplin metropolitan area, as designated by the federal government, and its goal is to provide for regional mobility. The PIP is a plan that allows the public to put input into regional transportation projects. The TIP contains transportation and transit projects in the Joplin Metropolitan Area that are partially funded by Federal transportation programs for a four-year period and the UPWP lists projects that are eligible for Federal transportation planning assistance.
