

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Joplin Area Transportation Study Organization (JATSO) is seeking comments on its 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment for several MAPS Transit Projects, which include the installation of various trolley shelters and benches, the purchase of furniture for the MAPS Administration building and miscellaneous vehicle equipment, and the construction of a new bus storage facility. Two TIP Amendments were previously approved by the JATSO Policy Board regarding installation of various benches and trolley shelters. These benches and trolley shelters are being amended to include a revision to the project cost amount. The MAPS Transit Projects for this TIP Amendment are funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The TIP contains transportation and transit projects in the Joplin Metropolitan Area that are partially funded by Federal transportation program for a four-year period.
