

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Joplin to enter into a Sub-Recipient Agreement with Jasper County Juvenile Detention Center in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty dollars (\$279,840.00) to pay salaries for staff to provide skills training as well as mental health, educational and skill services to juveniles in the City of Joplin who suffer from conditions related to the May 2011 tornado, authorizing the Director of Planning, Development and Neighborhood Services of the City of Joplin, Missouri to execute said Agreement; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011, an EF-5 tornado caused catastrophic damage to a significant portion of the City of Joplin; and

WHEREAS, there were was a negative public health impact, including education and mental health to juveniles due to the effects of the Tornado; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides assistance to communities that experience extreme disaster recovery circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joplin has been allocated CDBG-DR grant assistance in response to the losses caused by the tornado on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That the City enter into an Agreement no sooner than the Approval of the Release of Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has been received, or Agreement in substantially similar in form, between the City of Joplin and Jasper County Juvenile Detention Center in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty dollars (\$279,840.00) to pay salaries for staff to provide skills training as well as educational and mental health services to juveniles in the City of Joplin who suffer from conditions related to the May 2011 tornado.

Section 2. That the Director of Planning, Development and Neighborhood Services of the city of Joplin, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement, or Agreement in substantially similar in form, for and on behalf of the City of Joplin.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(1) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, in that said ordinance deals the immediate preservation of public health, and as such, is considered an emergency and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
