

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2016-130

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE approving the contract with Rosetta Construction, LLC, in the amount of Four Million, Seven Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand, Forty-Two and 30/100 (\$4,783,042.30) for the Sanitary Sewer Renovation Phase 2 project in the City of Joplin, Missouri; providing how the cost shall be made and levied; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2011, an EF-5 tornado caused catastrophic damage to a significant portion of the City of Joplin; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides assistance to communities that experience extreme disaster; and

WHEREAS, the City of Joplin was awarded \$113,276,000 in Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery assistance from HUD to aid in the City's recovery; and

WHEREAS, significant damage occurred to the City's infrastructure within the recovery area

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the contract be awarded with Rosetta Construction, LLC, in the amount of Four Million, Seven Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand, Forty-Two and 30/100 (\$4,783,042.30) for the Renovation Phase 2 project in the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 2. Upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor's work under said contract in writing by the Director of Public Works, and his certification to that effect to the director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid \$4,783,042.30 from the Community Development Block Grant Fund, Account Number 415-4542-540-8680 Project GFCDII.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make all necessary entries on the City records to show the increase in appropriations.

Section 4. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to proceed with said awarding of contract with Rosetta Construction, LLC.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) in that said ordinance provides for public improvements and is considered an emergency by the Council and as such shall become effective immediately upon this passage as provided by the Home Rule Charter for the City of Joplin. Specifically, this ordinance approves construction to begin immediately in the optimal construction time during the calendar year, and appropriations for this contract will be approved in the 2015-2016 budget.
