SUMMARY

This Council Bill approves a Construction Agreement with McClanahan Construction Company for the Turkey Creek WWTF Tertiary Filter Replacement project in the not to exceed amount of One Million, Five Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand, Six Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$1,538,600.00)

BACKGROUND

On April 15, 2019, Council approved a Work Authorization with Allgeier, Martin and Associates (AMA) to prepare bid documents for the Turkey Creek WWTF Tertiary Filter Replacement project. The project was advertised in accordance with the City of Joplin's procurement policies. Bids from 3 contractors were opened on August 15, 2019; McClanahan Construction Company was confirmed to be the lowest bidder. The low bid was below the Engineer's estimate. The project generally consists of replacing the last two sand trough filters with diamond fabric filters. This project is being done to increase treatment capacity, as well as, to add critical redundancy to the treatment of wastewater prior to discharging it into Turkey Creek.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Wastewater Treatment fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of this Council Bill on an Emergency basis; being an ordinance relating to a public improvement is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin, Missouri and the Council hereby declares that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
